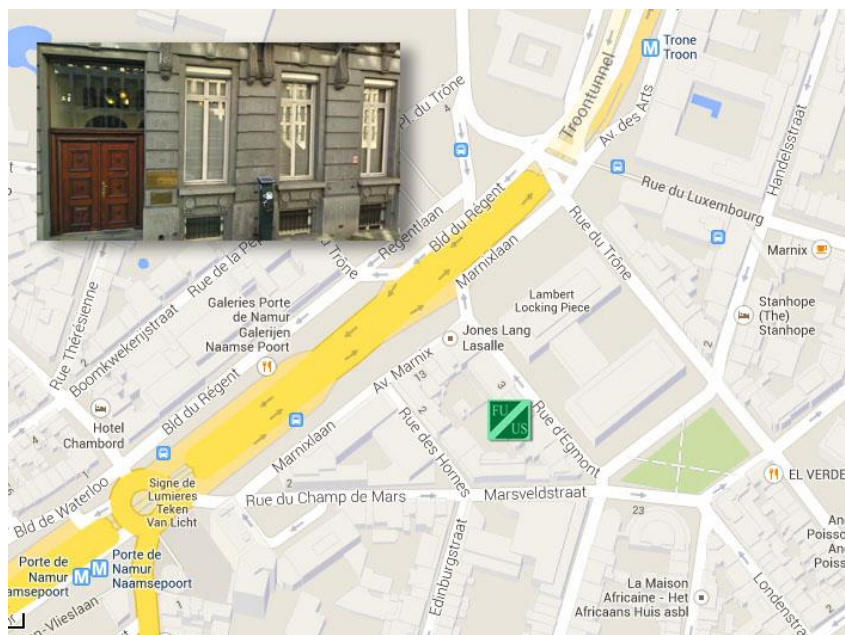

HOW TO GET TO THE MEETING SITE?

- **From the Brussels Airport – Zaventem**

From the airport take the bus IC 4037 (direction Charleroi-Sud) and get off at Bru.-Luxemburg/brux.-Luxembourg stop. Then walk for about 8 minutes to reach the site.

- **By Public Transport**

The University Foundation is located in Rue D'Egmont 11- just between two underground stations (Troon/Trône and Porte de Namur/Naamsepoort).

- **By Car**

Take the tunnels until the exit Porte de Namur/Naamsepoort (make sure you have enough small change for your parking fee).

- **By Train**

Take the train from Airport Zaventem (floor -1) to Bruxelles-Luxembourg. From there go to Rue D'Egmont 11.
